912 households responded

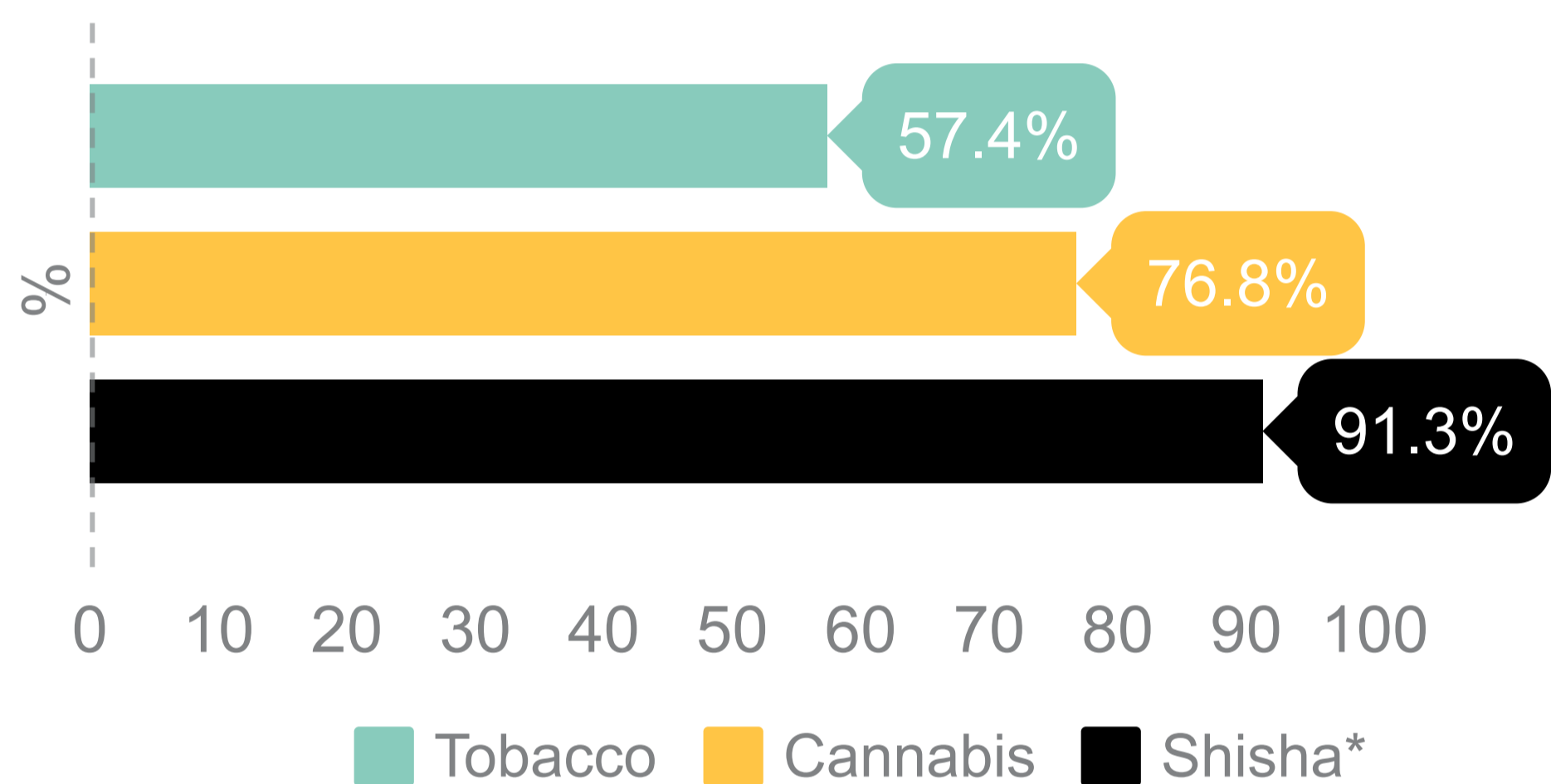


72% do not currently smoke cannabis, tobacco and/or shisha



68% reside in seniors apartment building

SMOKING IN HOMES & HEALTH IMPACTS

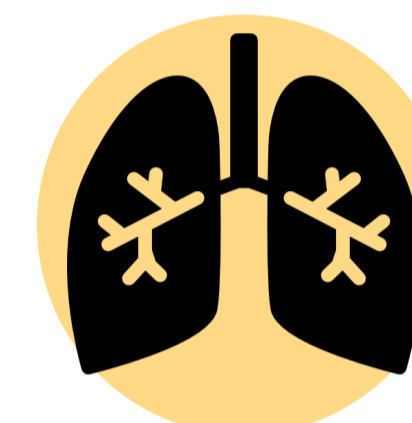


Most residents do not allow smoking anywhere inside (including balcony/deck/patio)



60%

reported exposure to second hand tobacco smoke in their home, including smoke drifting into homes from outside.

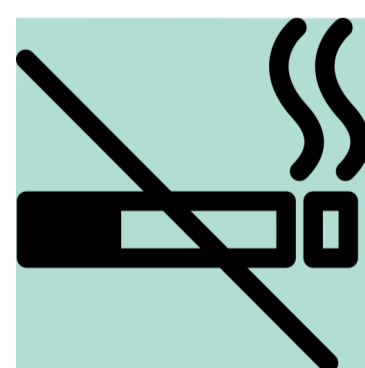


43%*

reported at least 1 person in their household have health problems that worsen with exposure to second-hand smoke

80% of respondents understand that breathing in second hand smoke from tobacco is harmful to a person's health

SMOKE-FREE POLICY SUPPORT



38%* do not think CHH should make a smoke-free policy in all CHH buildings



80% think smoking should be prohibited within 9 metres from CHH building entrances/exits



51% are concerned that current residents may still smoke in their homes if a smoke-free policy is in place
